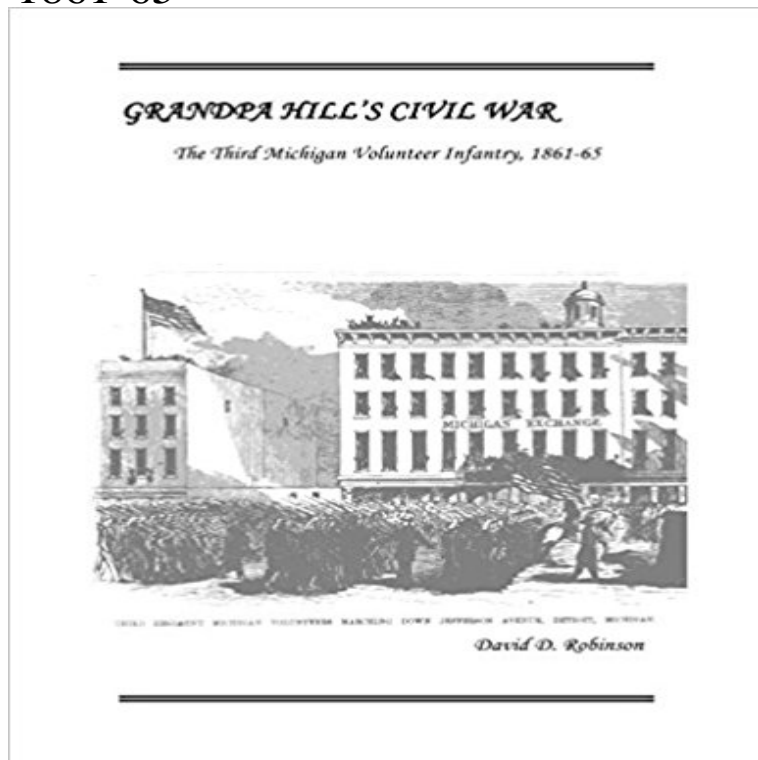


Grandpa Hills Civil War: The Third Michigan Volunteer Infantry, 1861-65



This book follows records of the Third Michigan Volunteer Infantry and its successor Fifth Michigan Volunteer Infantry from May, 1861 to June, 1865. Transcriptions of soldiers letters, veterans memoirs, official records and newspaper stories that mention the Third Michigan tell their story. Many records mention commanders names. Third Michigan company commanders and all regimental, brigade, division, corps commanders and commanding generals in their chain of command are profiled, as are Confederate commanders and organizations they opposed. Warren Hill enlisted in the Third Michigan at 15. He and 107 other soldiers and officers served in Company K. Company K soldiers records tell what happened to each Company K soldier and officer, when promoted, discharged for disability, deserted, court martialed, died of illness or killed or missing in action, or returned to duty. Increasingly sophisticated weapons, tactics, organizations, occupational specialties, communications, and other innovations emerge from the records.
