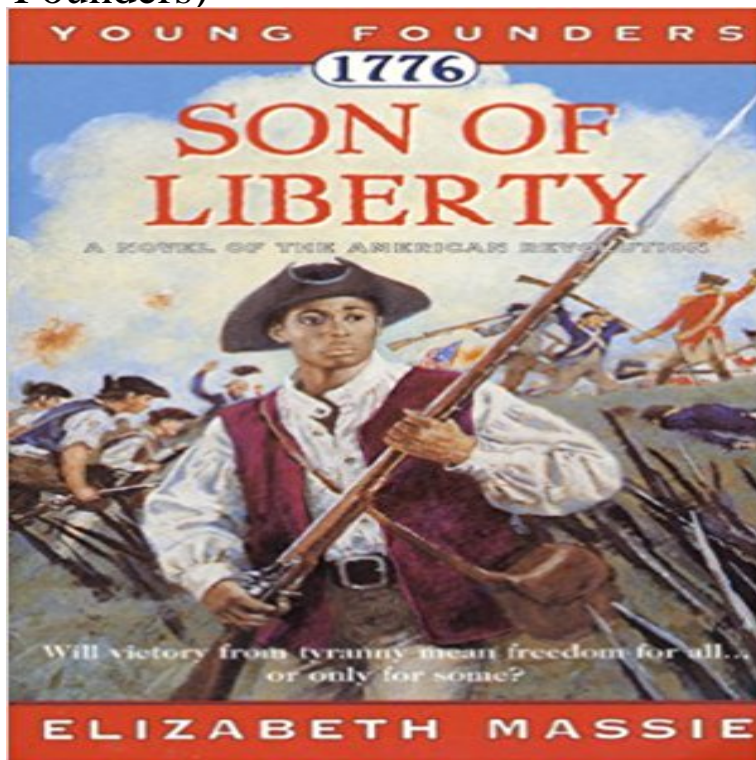


1776: Son of Liberty: A Novel of the American Revolution (Young Founders)
