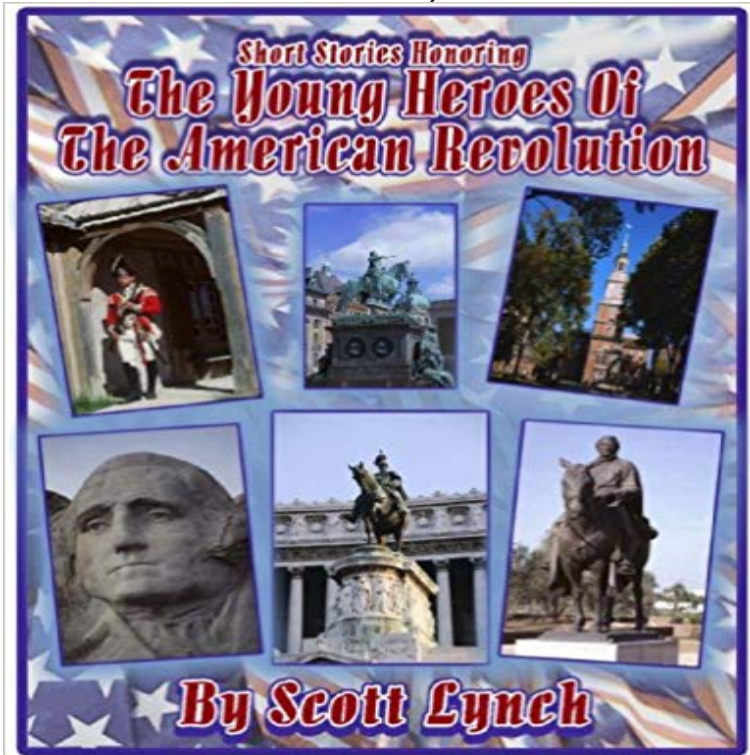


14. Incident on a Small Connecticut Field (Young Heroes of the American Revolution)
