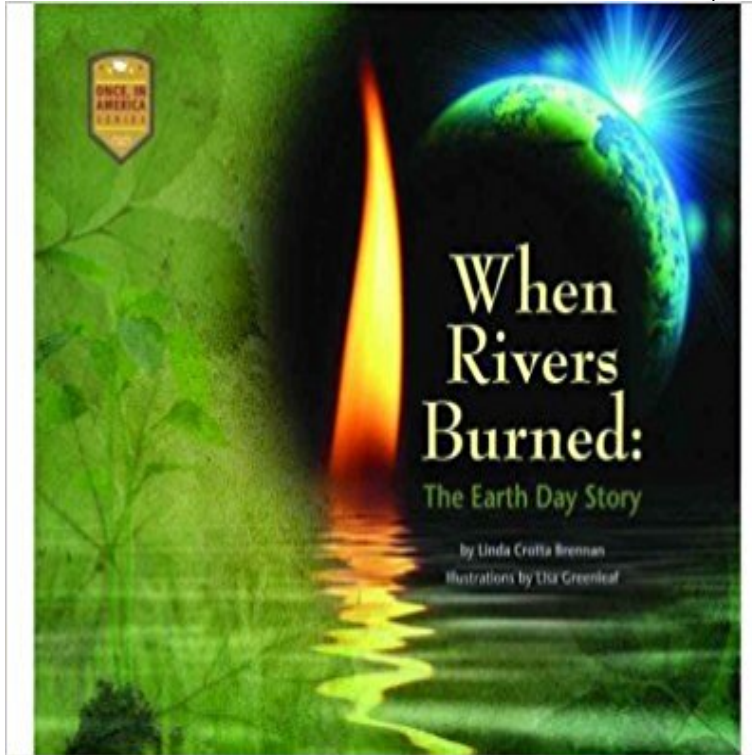


When Rivers Burned: The Earth Day Story (Once, in America)
