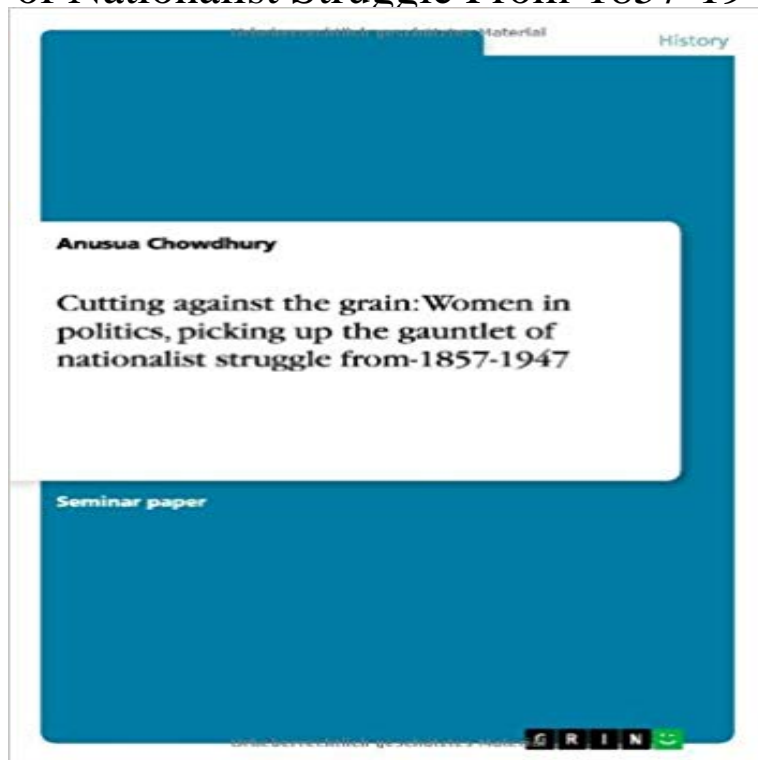


## Cutting Against the Grain: Women in Politics, Picking Up the Gauntlet of Nationalist Struggle From-1857-1947

Multiple shades of heroism, heterogeneity of diverse cultures and religions were encapsulated in the early 20th cent. freedom movement of India. The paper unravels how the super-imposed patriarchy held womens actions at bay; and how in the last, they were drawn into the whirlpool of the movement. Nonetheless, the subtlety of their heroism created a deep mark in the history of Modern India. The paper explores the integration of disparate ideological and political groupings; and an eclectic blend of womens aestheticism and the chivalrous masculinity of men.
