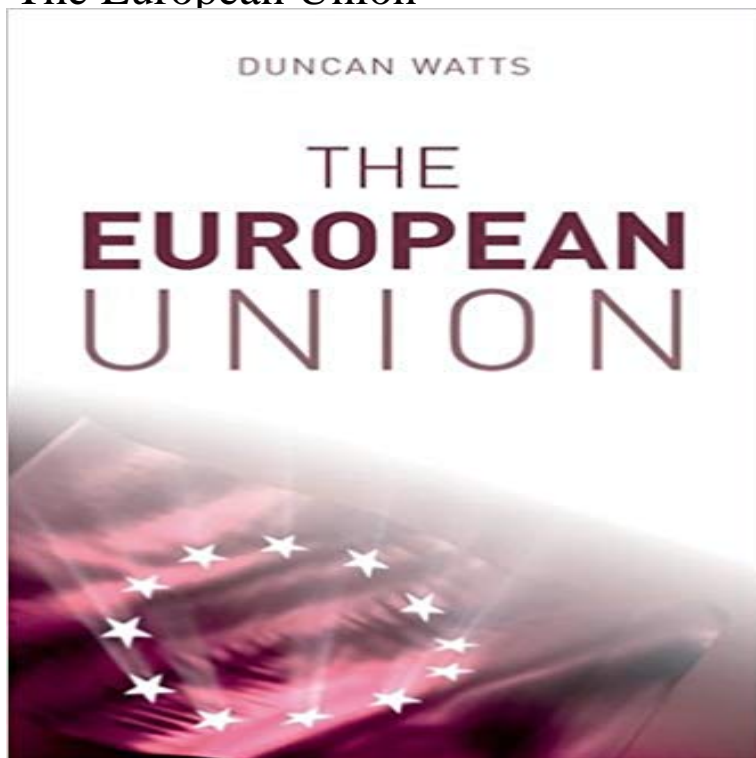


## The European Union
