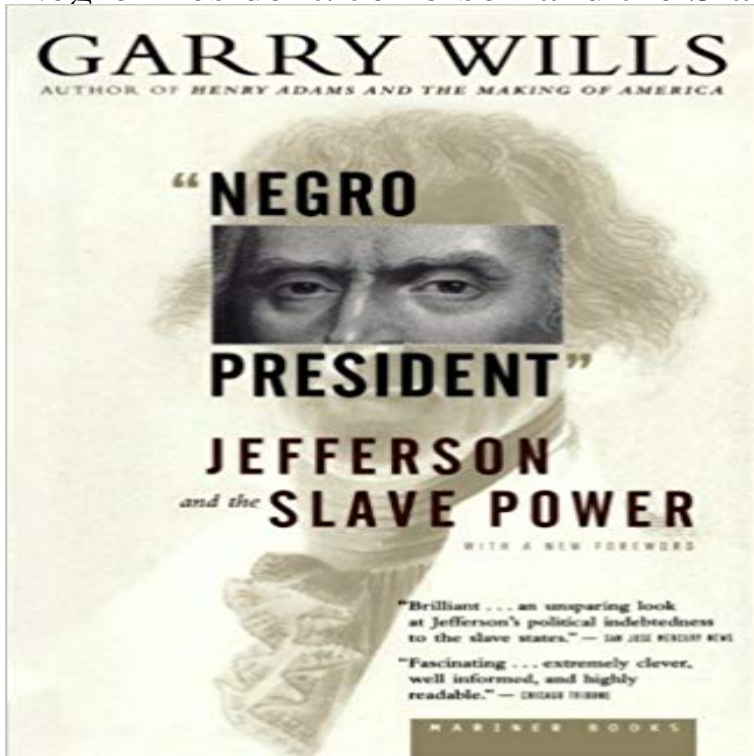


Negro President: Jefferson and the Slave Power
