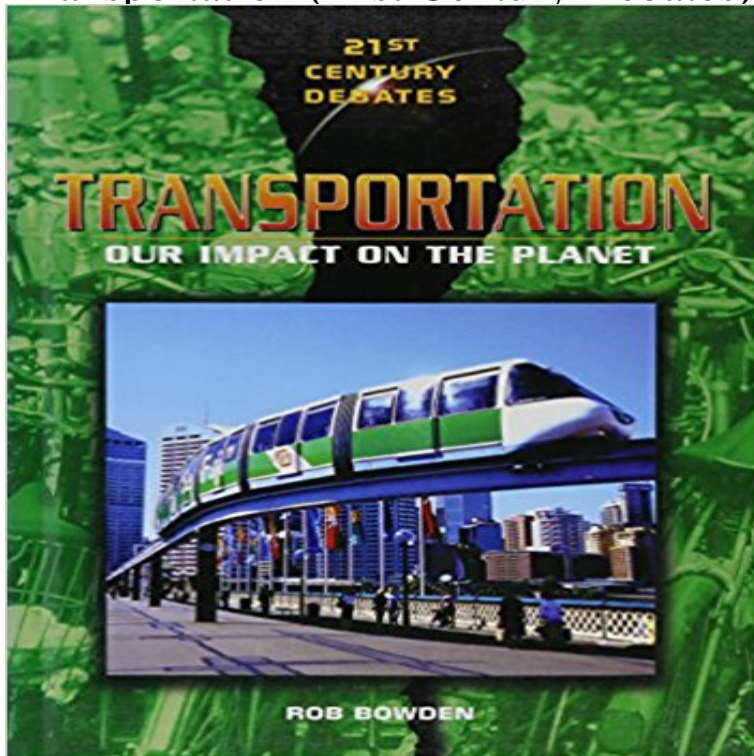


Transportation (21st Century Debates)
