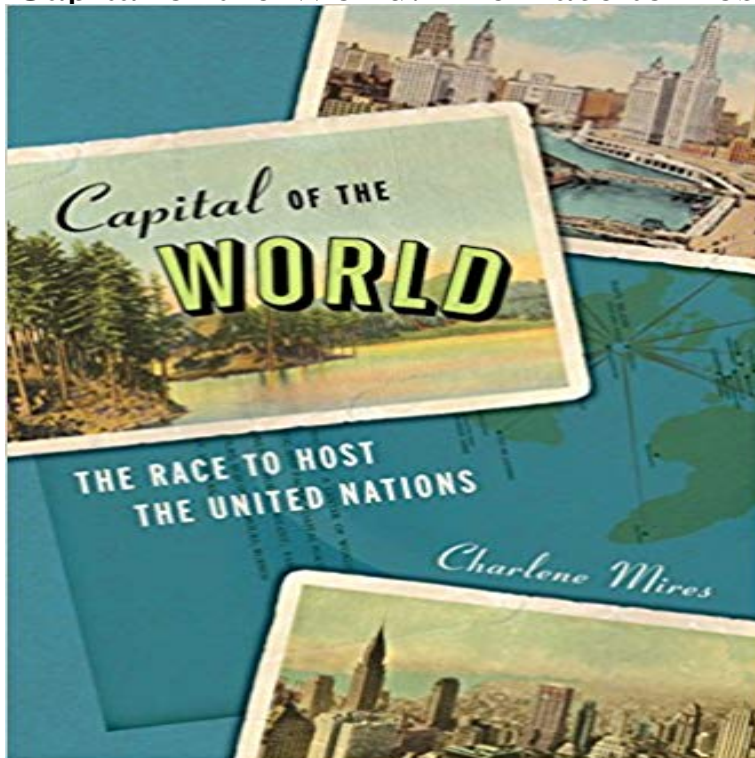


Capital of the World: The Race to Host the United Nations

And for its part, New York worked mightily just to stay in the race it would eventually win. With a sweeping view of the United States place in the world at the end of World War II, Capital of the World tells the dramatic, surprising, and at times comic story of hometown promoters in pursuit of an extraordinary prize and the diplomats who struggled with the balance of power at a pivotal moment in history.
