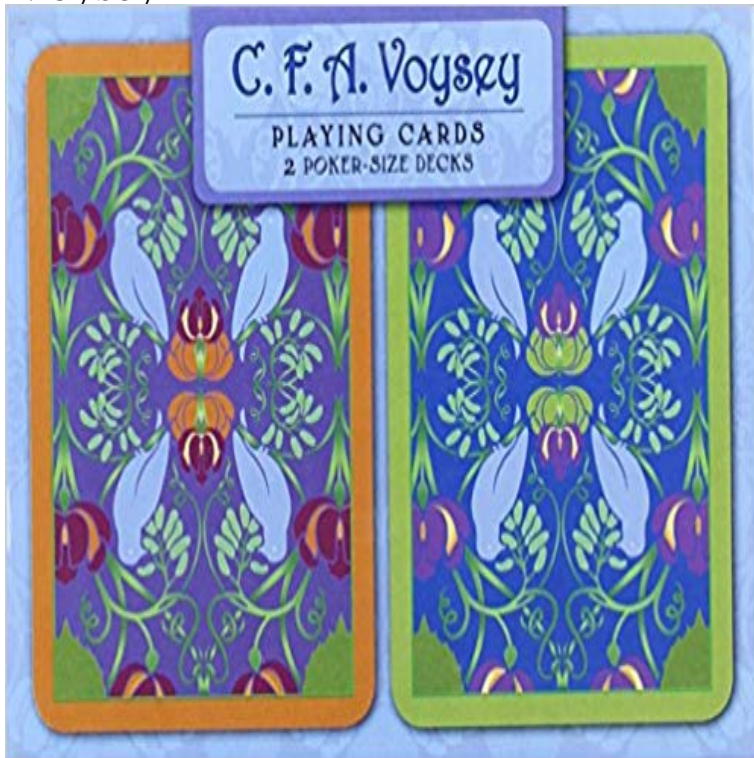


Voysey
