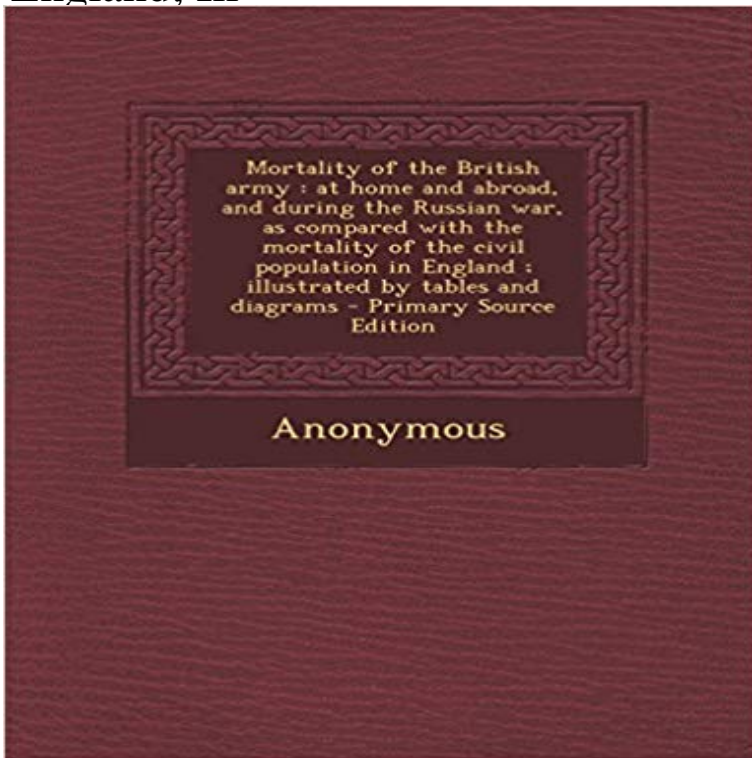


Mortality of the British Army: At Home and Abroad, and During the Russian War, as Compared with the Mortality of the Civil Population in England; Ill
