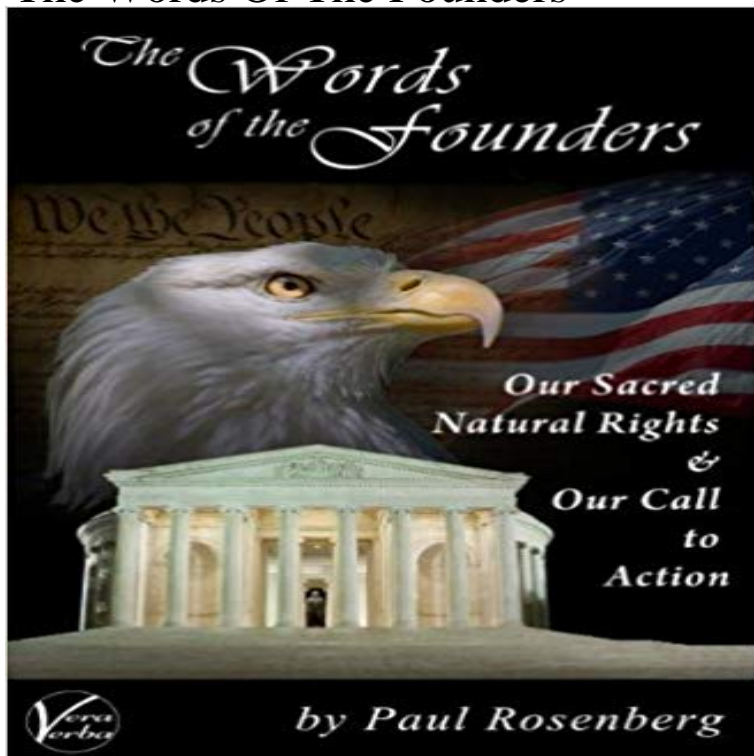


## The Words Of The Founders
