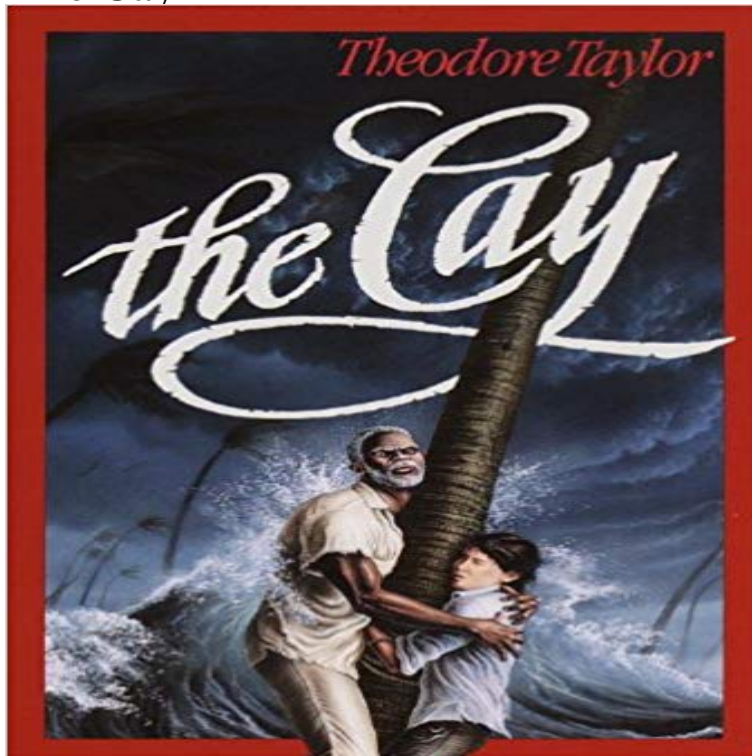


The Cay
