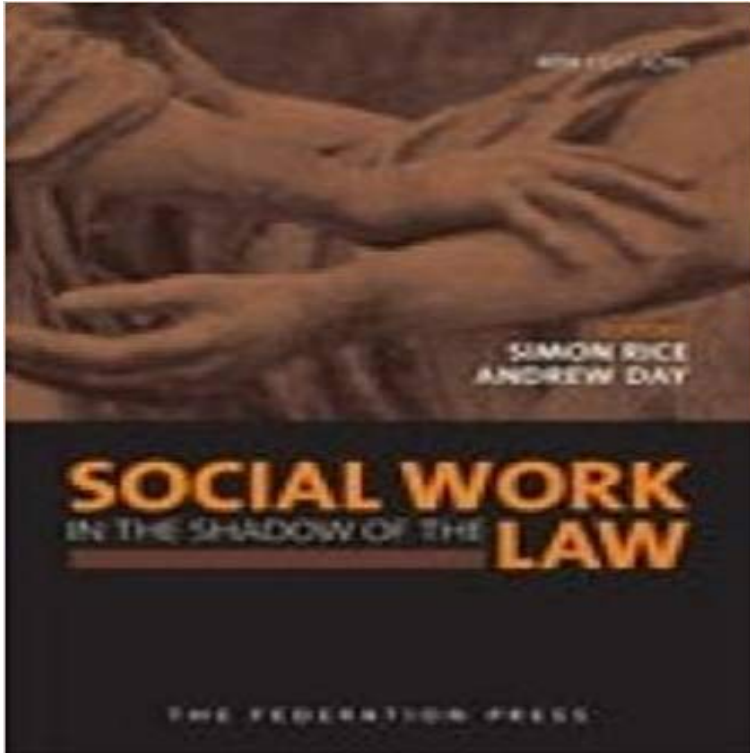


## Social Work in the Shadow of the Law

The final section of the book considers the legal issues that arise in the social workers own practice, addressing matters such as confidentiality and ethics, courts, tribunals and interpreters, record keeping, administrative law, and evidentiary rules.
