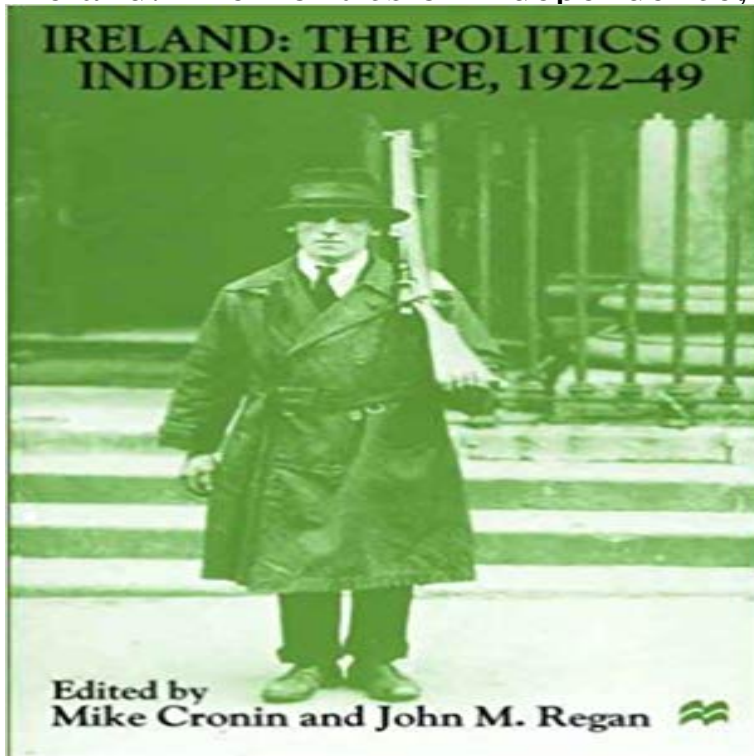


## Ireland: The Politics of Independence, 1922-49
