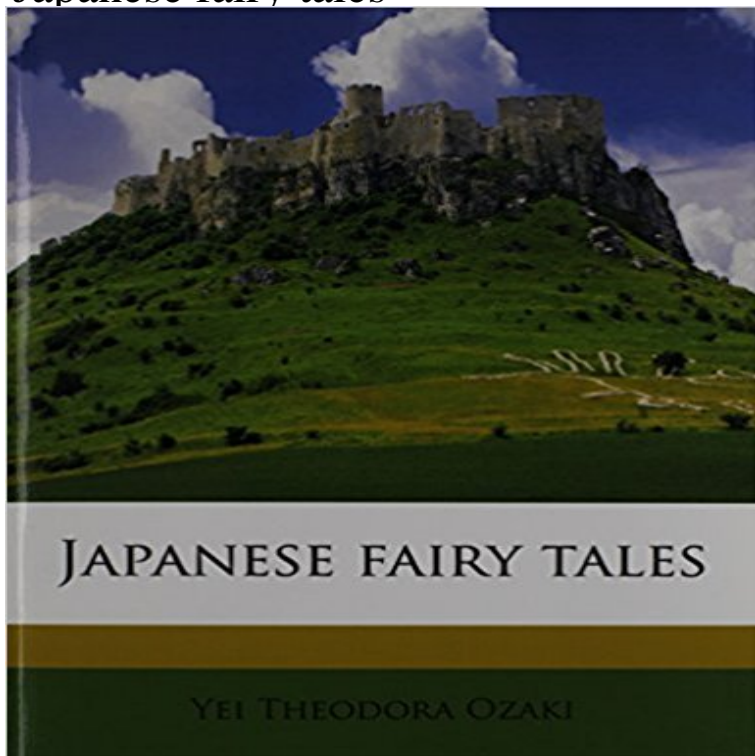


Japanese fairy tales
