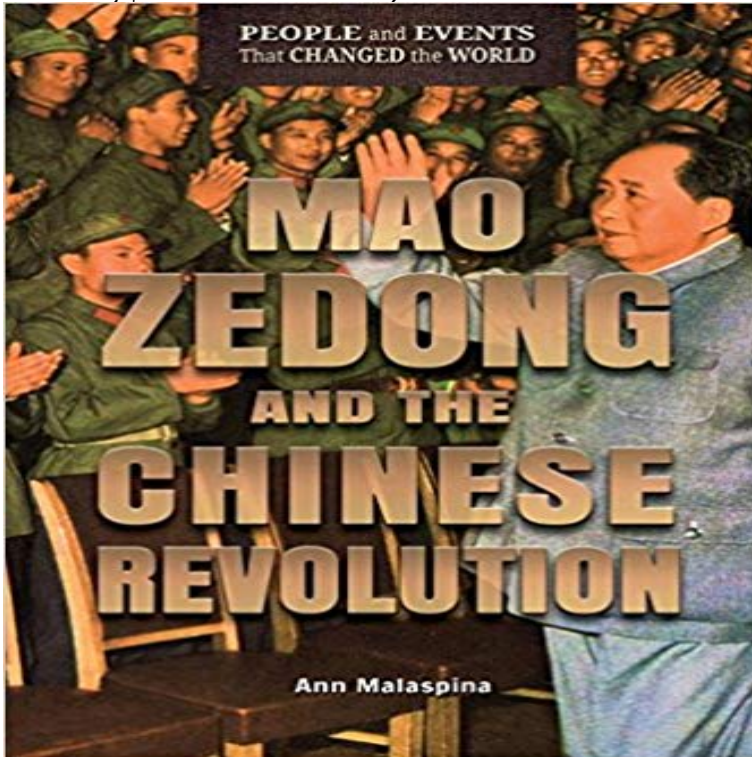


Mao Zedong and the Chinese Revolution (People and Events That Changed the World)
