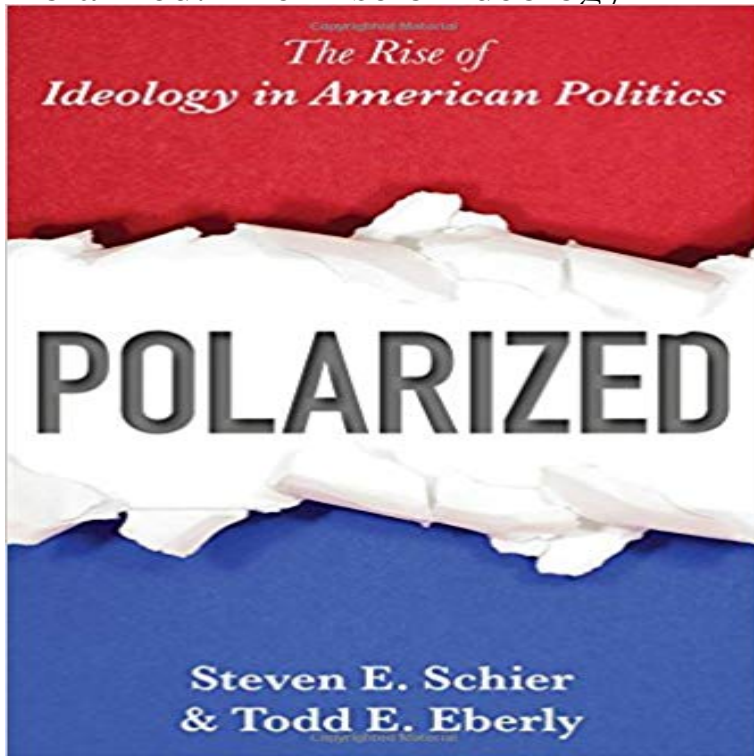


Polarized: The Rise of Ideology in American Politics
