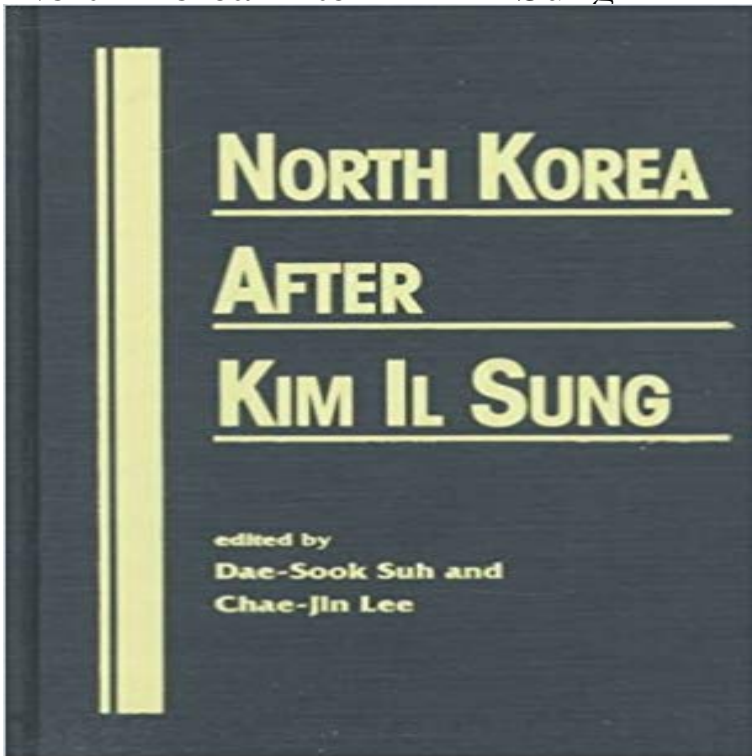


North Korea After Kim Il Sung
