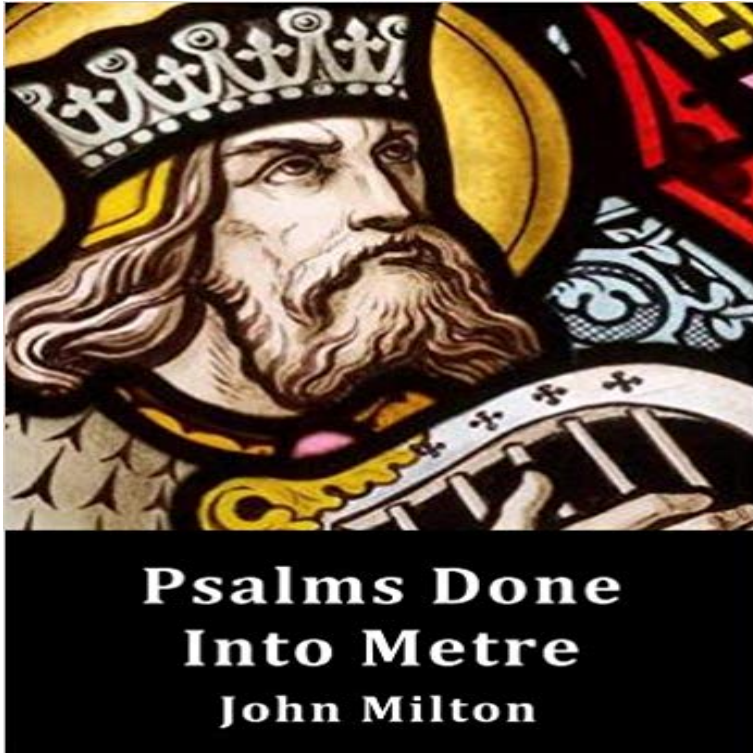


Psalms Done Into Metre



Poetic versions of the Psalms 1, 2, 3, 4, 5, 6, 7, 8, 80, 81, 82, 83, 84, 85, 86, 114, 136 by John Milton (1608-1674), including two psalms written when he was 15 years old. Milton was an English poet, polemicist, a scholarly man of letters, and a civil servant for the Commonwealth (republic) of England under Oliver Cromwell. He wrote at a time of religious conflict and political upheaval, and is best known for his epic poem Paradise Lost.
