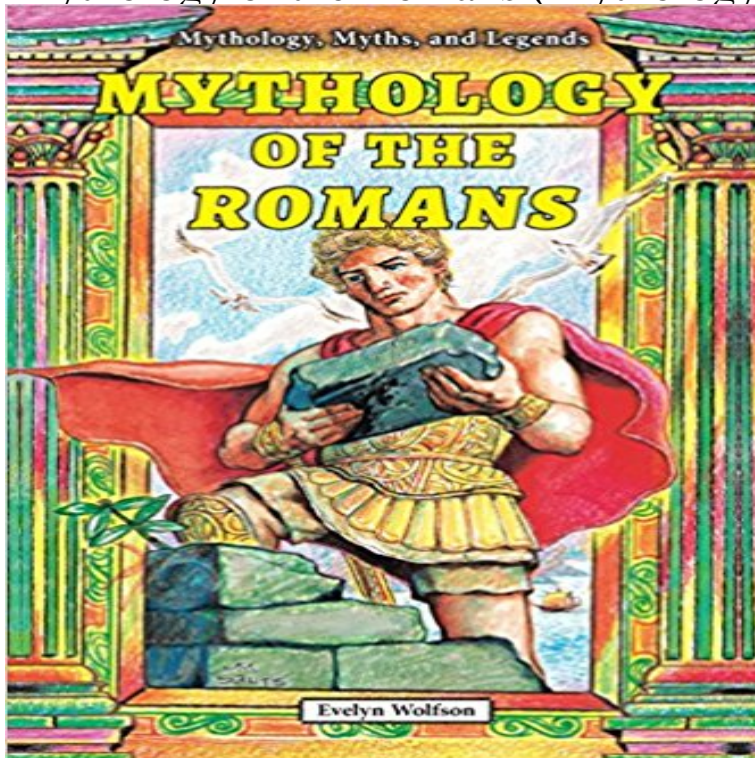


Mythology of the Romans (Mythology, Myths, and Legends)
