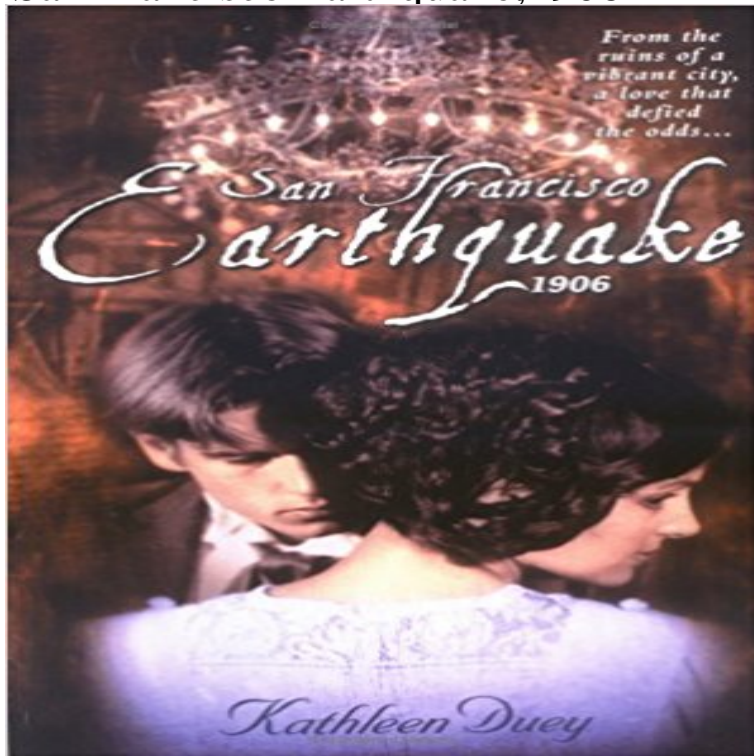


San Francisco Earthquake,1906
