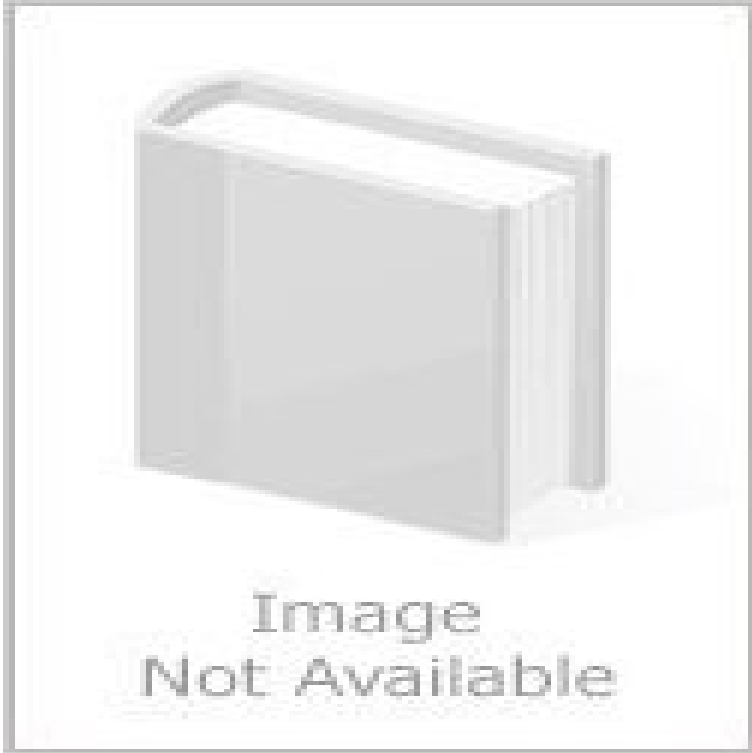


Spain in the Age of Exploration (Cultures of the Past)
