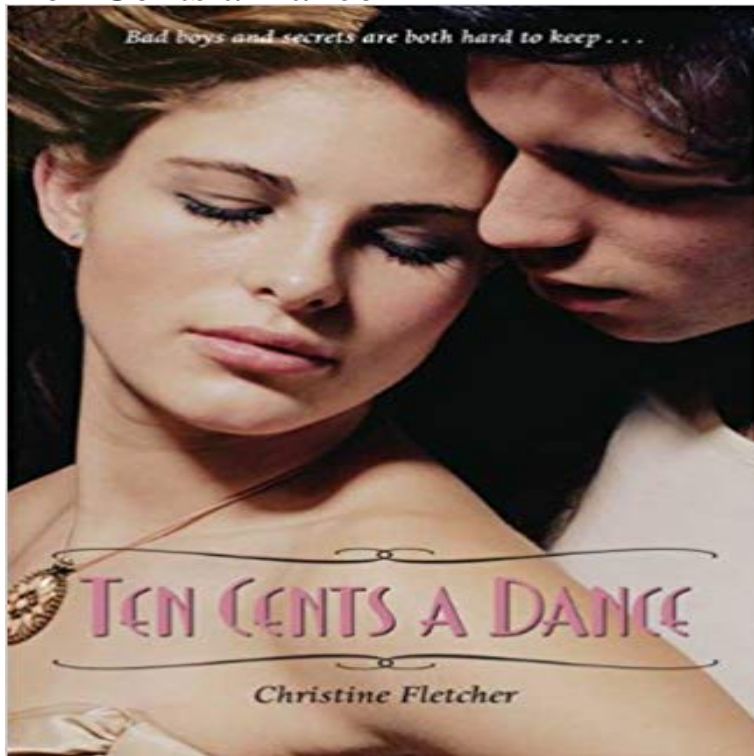


Ten Cents a Dance
