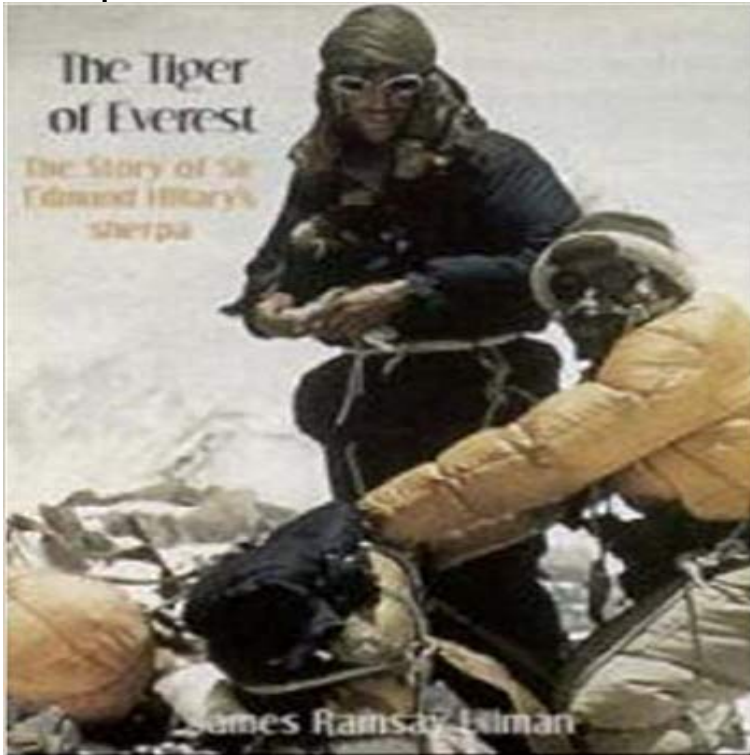


Man of Everest: The Story of Tenzing Norgay, Sir Edmund Hillarys Sherpa
