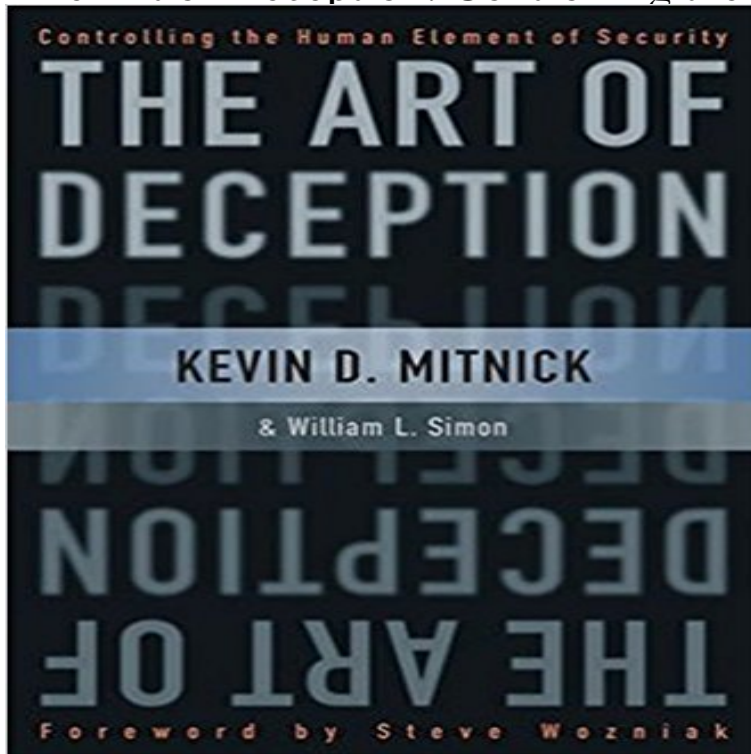


The Art of Deception: Controlling the Human Element of Security
