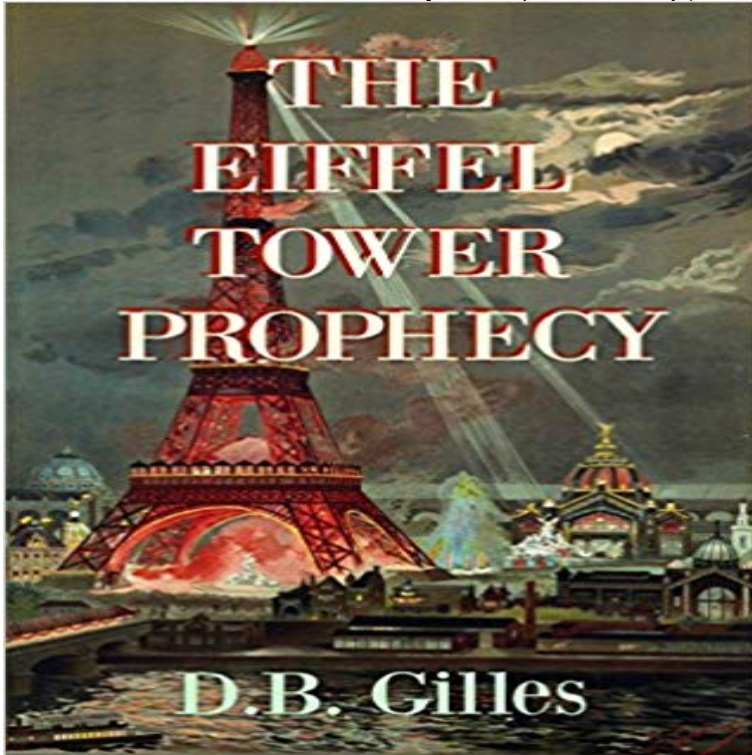


## The Eiffel Tower Prophecy: Young Adult Time Travel Thriller
