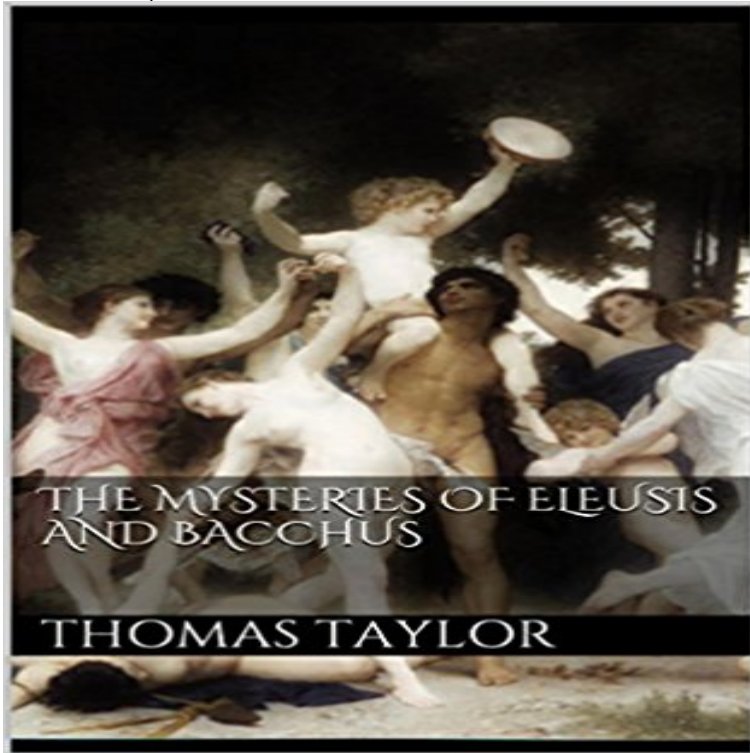


The Mysteries of Eleusis and Bacchus
