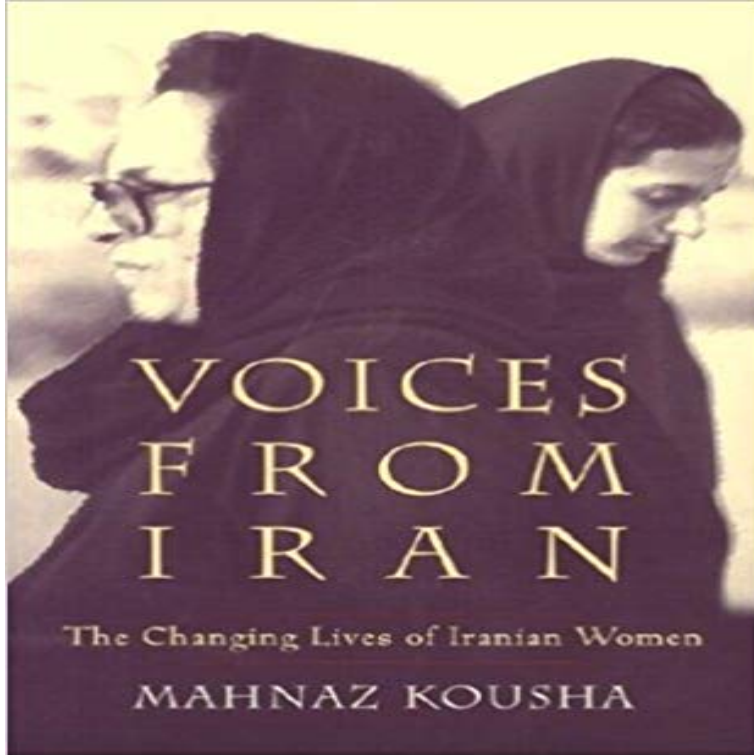


## Voices From Iran: The Changing Lives of Iranian Women (Gender, Culture, and Politics in the Middle East)
