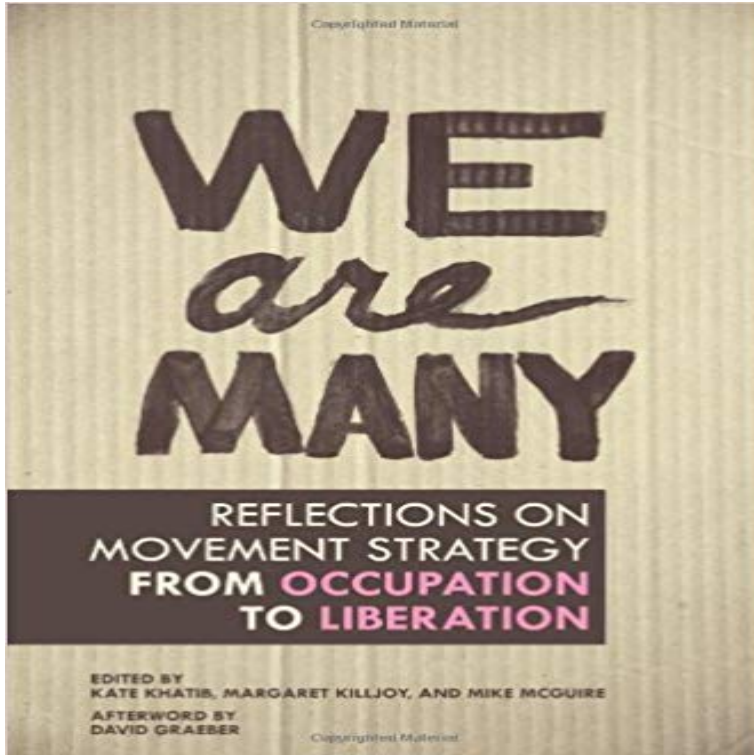


We Are Many: Reflections on Movement Strategy from Occupation to Liberation
