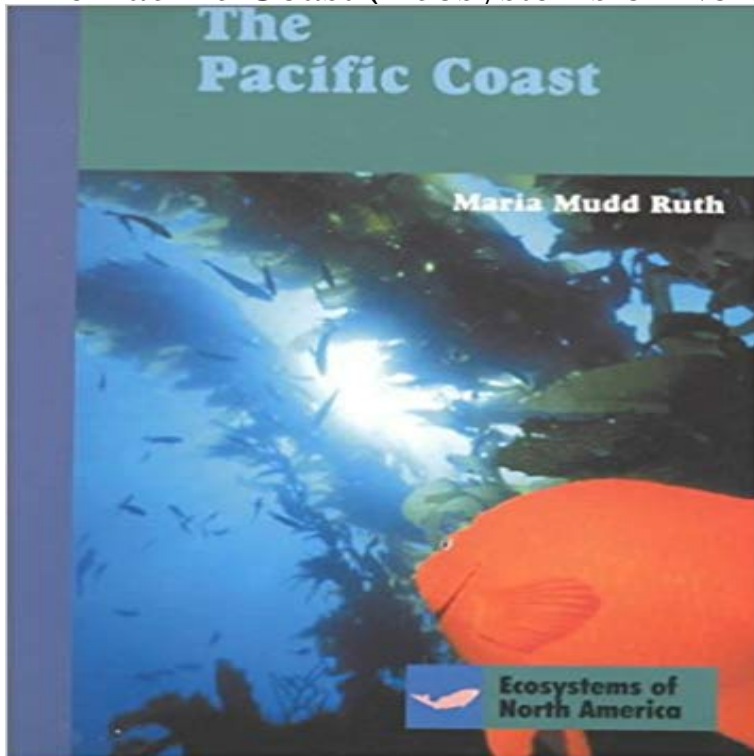


The Pacific Coast (Ecosystems of North America)
